

## Energy Tariffs and Associated Charges

The tariffs applied to the on-supply arrangement are in-line with the local area retailer's standing offer (Ergon Energy). **The following tables are an excerpt from the tariffs and charges section on the Ergon website as at 27 June 2016.**

### Small business tariffs

Small businesses tariffs are designed to meet the unique energy needs of our small business customers, using less than 100MWh per year.

#### **General supply tariffs**

On a general supply tariff, you pay for the electricity you use at a flat rate throughout the day and night, plus a daily supply charge.

#### **Tariff 20 General Supply**

This tariff is the most common tariff for small businesses, providing a continuous supply of electricity day and night at a flat rate, plus a daily supply charge. It's suitable for small businesses that use most of their electricity during the daytime.

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#### **Demand tariffs**

On a demand tariff, you're charged for the total amount of electricity you use plus a demand charge and a daily supply charge.

The demand charge is based on measuring the maximum amount of electricity you use at any point during your billing period.

When you choose a demand tariff, your whole business must be connected to that tariff.

### Tariff 41 Low Voltage General Supply (Demand)

### Transitional and obsolescent tariffs

#### Tariff 21 General Supply (Transitional)

Tariff 21 cannot be used in conjunction with Tariff 20, 22, 22A or 62. It will be phased out no later than 30 June 2020.

### Tariff 22 General Supply Time of Use

During the peak period between 7am and 9pm on weekdays, Tariff 22 is priced higher than in the off-peak period. It's generally better suited to businesses with a good proportion of night and weekend electricity usage.

This tariff will be phased out for Ergon Energy customers no later than 30 June 2017 and is not available to new customers.

### Tariff 22 (Small and Large) General Supply Time of Use (Transitional)

During the peak period between 7am and 9pm on weekdays, this transitional tariff is priced higher than in the off-peak period. It may be suitable for customers with a good proportion of night and weekend electricity usage.

It will be phased out no later than 30 June 2020.

## **Large business tariffs**

Large businesses tariffs are designed to meet the unique energy needs of our large business customers, using more than 100MWh per year. Customers have the option to switch between large business tariffs once in a 12 month period.

### **Demand tariffs**

Most large business tariffs are demand-based. On a demand tariff, you're charged for the total amount of electricity you use plus a demand charge and a daily supply charge.

The demand charge is based on measuring the maximum amount of electricity you use at any point during your billing period.

When you choose a demand tariff, your whole business must be connected to that tariff.

### **Tariff 44 Demand Small**

This tariff has a charge for the total amount of electricity used (kWh), plus a demand charge (kW) for the relevant billing period and a supply charge. The demand threshold under this tariff is 30kW.

### **Tariff 45 Demand Medium**

This tariff has a charge for the total amount of electricity used (kWh), plus a demand charge (kW) for the relevant billing period and a supply charge. The demand threshold under this tariff is 120kW.

### Tariff 46 Demand Large

This tariff has a charge for the total amount of electricity used (kWh), plus a demand charge (kW) for the relevant billing period and a supply charge. The demand threshold under this tariff is 400kW.

### Tariff 47 Demand High Voltage

This tariff has a charge for the total amount of electricity used (kWh), plus a demand charge (kW) for the relevant billing period and a supply charge. The demand threshold under this tariff is 400kW.

Demand charge - dollars per kW of chargeable demand per month	26.732	28.486
All usage - cents per kWh	10.791	12.724
Supply charge - cents per day	42,918.902	45,686.523

### Tariff 48 Demand (>4 GWh)

This tariff has a charge for the total amount of electricity used (kWh), plus a demand charge (kW) for the relevant billing period and a supply charge. The demand threshold under this tariff is 400kW.

This tariff is only available to Connection Asset Customers (electricity usage generally >4GWh per year) and Individually Calculated Customers (electricity usage generally >40GWh per year).

### Transitional and obsolescent tariffs

#### Tariff 20 (Large) General Supply (Transitional)

This tariff provides a continuous supply of electricity day and night, and is suitable for businesses that use most of their electricity during the daytime plus a daily supply charge.

It will be phased out no later than 30 June 2020.

All usage - cents per kWh	33.953	38.434
Supply charge - cents per day	69.410	78.572

### Tariff 22 (Small and Large) General Supply Time of Use (Transitional)

During the peak period between 7am and 9pm on weekdays, this transitional tariff is priced higher than in the off-peak period. It may be suitable for customers with a good proportion of night and weekend electricity usage.

It will be phased out no later than 30 June 2020.
